The multi-density two-ply filters remove pollutants as small as one micron while simultaneously destroying most microorganisms on contact. The bottom portion hinges open for quick and easy filter replacement. With no airflow discharging straight down, complaints of cold drafts blowing on workers is eliminated.

"By eliminating complaints of drafts and allergic reactions to duct pollution, companies save money from fewer sick days taken and increased productivity," explains David Northcutt, inventor of the system and president of International Diversified Marketing Inc. "Additional saving comes from fewer workers compensation claims and employee lawsuits.
